Le Coromandel Outdoor Language Centre a ouvert ses portes en 1988, avec pour objectif d'offrir un enseignement de qualité de la langue anglaise, dans un environnement permettant de vivre une expérience unique et authentique en Nouvelle-Zélande. Nous sommes membre de ENGLISH NEW ZEALAND et de IALC (International Association of Language Centres).

### **Cadre**

Whitianga est située dans la belle Baie de Mercury. C'est une petite ville qui se trouve en bordure de mer, riche en histoire et en beauté naturelle. Lieu de débarquement de Kupe le premier Maori et du capitaine Cook, un millier d'années plus tard, Whitianga est bordée de magnifiques plages de sable fin. L'école se situe à proximité du port.

Le Coromandel Outdoor Language Centre offre à ses étudiants la possibilité d'apprendre l'anglais selon diverses formules : cours intensifs en classe, cours-activités et séjours en famille au sein d'une petite communauté où il est facile de se faire des amis et de se sentir à l'aise.

### **Cours du matin**

Avec un maximum de 10 étudiants par classe nos cours du matin, du niveau débutant au niveau avancé, sont basés sur des livres récents, complétés par un éventail de ressources variées comme par exemple l'utilisation de cassettes, vidéos, jeux linguistiques, journaux et magazines. Nos professeurs sont qualifiés et expérimentés ; ils utilisent une approche communicative incorporant jeux de rôles, théâtre et discussions en classe.

Les quatre volets de l'apprentissage de la langue qui sont parler, écouter, lire et écrire sont abordés en mettant l'accent sur la communication orale.

Les cours sont ouverts en permanence, permettant ainsi aux étudiants de commencer n'importe quel lundi du mois. Les nouveaux étudiants passent un test d'évaluation afin de déterminer leur niveau et permettre ainsi de les affecter dans la classe leur correspondant au mieux.

### **Cours Activités**

Au cours de l'après-midi, les étudiants peuvent participer à notre programme d'activités. L'idée est de compléter et d'approfondir les cours du matin. Tout en offrant distraction et amusement, ils permettent aux étudiants d'enrichir leur vocabulaire en favorisant l'utilisation de l'anglais ailleurs qu'en classe, à savoir pendant les activités extérieures et dans les familles d'accueil.

Les activités incluant sport et arts, donnent aux étudiants l'opportunité d'explorer l'environnement et de rencontrer les artisans locaux. Leur professeur en charge des activités encourage les étudiants à parler anglais dans des situations variées et de façon naturelle, où la langue anglaise n'est pas le premier but. On insiste beaucoup sur learning by doing.

### **Cours intensifs**

En plus des cours d'Anglais normaux le matin s'ajoutent des cours d'anglais pratiques l'après-midi, soit un total de 21 heures de cours en classe par semaine.

### **Cours de préparation aux examens**

L'école organise, plusieurs fois par an, des cours de préparation aux examens internationaux. Les étudiants (niveau moyen requis au minimum) suivent normalement les cours du matin et ont ensuite des cours spéciaux de deux heures l'après-midi destinés à leur faire réussir le IELTS ou le Cambridge First Certificate. Se référer à la liste pour de plus amples détails.

### **Cours plus surf**

Les étudiants peuvent, s'ils souhaitent, prendre part aux cours de surf ou de bodyboard, qui dure 3 semaines. Ceci combinant les cours du matin plus des cours de surf d'après-midi. Se référer à la liste pour de plus amples détails.

### **Cours particuliers**

Les étudiants peuvent aussi opter pour des cours particuliers l'après-midi. Ces cours sont préparés de façon à répondre aux différents besoins de chaque étudiant.

### **Cours spéciaux**

Si un étudiant le désire nous pouvons combiner les cours du matin avec des cours spéciaux l'après-midi comme le golf, l'art.

### **Séjour en famille d'accueil**

Le séjour en famille d'accueil est aussi un aspect important de notre programme. Nos familles d'accueil se considèrent comme partie intégrante de l'école et se font un honneur de recevoir chez eux des étudiants étrangers. L'école garantit la qualité de l'accueil par une sélection rigoureuse des familles et s'efforce de les informer des divers problèmes pouvant se présenter aux étudiants étrangers lors de leur adaptation au mode de vie néo-zélandais. Nous ne plaçons jamais deux étudiants de même nationalité dans une famille d'accueil. Les familles offrent le petit déjeuner et le dîner en semaine ainsi que le déjeuner en week-end.

### **Transfert**

Les étudiants sont accueillis à l'aéroport international d'Auckland et transférés en taxi/mini bus dans leur famille d'accueil. Nous proposons également un service de transfert vers l'aéroport d'Auckland pour les étudiants qui en font la demande.

### **Informations**

Lors de leur première journée à l'école, les étudiants reçoivent dans leur langue maternelle une introduction détaillée sur le fonctionnement de l'école et un aperçu de la ville. Ils sont invités à poser leurs questions.

Par la suite, les autres demandes d'informations en langue maternelle sont organisées sur rendez-vous.

Nous encourageons les étudiants à utiliser l'anglais en permanence.

Notre personnel est à la disposition des étudiants pour rendre leur séjour à notre école le plus agréable possible.

### **Séjours en groupe**

Le Coromandel Outdoor Language Centre reçoit également des groupes intéressés par des voyages d'études à court terme (de 1 à 4 semaines). Les séjours peuvent être programmés en fonction de vos besoins et inclure en fin de séjour une courte visite du pays.

Un Certificat est décerné à tous les étudiants qui achèvent nos cours avec succès.

Grâce à la qualité de son enseignement, son site magnifique et son programme unique de cours et d'activités, nous sommes convaincus que le Coromandel Language Centre offre à ses étudiants un moyen extrêmement agréable et efficace de l'apprentissage de l'anglais.

**“LEARNING BY DOING”**

**Coromandel Outdoor Language Centre** opened in 1988 with the aim of providing a high standard of English tuition in a setting capable of offering a truly unique New Zealand experience. We are members of ENGLISH NEW ZEALAND and of IALC (International Association of Language Centres).

### **THE TOWN**

Whitianga is located on the beautiful Mercury Bay. It is a seaside resort town, rich in both history and natural beauty. Landing place of Kupe, the first Maori, and of Captain Cook a thousand years later, Whitianga is surrounded by white sandy beaches and forest covered hills. The school is situated on the harbourside.

Here, Coromandel Outdoor Language Centre offers students the chance to learn English with a variety of course options in a small community where they will make friends and feel at home.

### **MORNING LESSONS**

With a maximum of 10 students per class, our morning classes, from beginner to advanced, are based on modern textbooks, supplemented by a variety of other material such as CDs, DVDs, language games, newspapers and magazines. Our teachers are qualified and experienced; they use a communicative approach incorporating role play, drama, singing and discussions in their lessons. The four skills of speaking, listening, reading and writing are all thoroughly covered, but the emphasis is generally on oral communication.

Classes are open-ended so students may begin on any Monday, and are promoted to higher levels depending on their individual progress. New students are given a written and oral placement test so that they can be placed in the most suitable class.

### **ACTIVITY COURSE**

In the afternoons, students can take part in the Activity Programme. This is intended to supplement and enhance the morning classes.

Activities include both crafts and sports, and give students the opportunity to explore the environment and to meet local craftspeople. Their activity teachers encourage them to practise conversational English in a variety of natural situations, where language is not the main focus. This is truly "Learning by Doing".

### **GENERAL COURSE**

This course combines the normal morning lessons with afternoon classes based on functional English, for a total of 21 classroom hours per week. There is also an option to join our Activity Programme on Fridays: "General Plus" course.

### **EXAMINATION PREPARATION CLASSES**

The school runs examination preparation classes. Students (at least intermediate level) take the normal morning class and a special 2 hour afternoon class, with a maximum of 6 students, aimed at helping them pass IELTS or Cambridge First Certificate. See the Price List for more details.

### **ENGLISH PLUS SURFING**

This is a 3 week course combining morning English lessons and afternoon surfing or bodyboarding lessons. See the Price list for more details.

### **PRIVATE LESSONS**

Students may also choose private one-to-one lessons in the afternoons. These are individually prepared to the students' needs.

### **SPECIAL INTEREST AFTERNOON COURSES**

We can provide a quotation for individual students to combine morning classes with special interest afternoon classes. Examples are NZ cooking, golf, bone carving or Environmental.

### **HOMESTAY**

We also regard homestay as a very important part of our programme. Our host families feel that they are part of the school, and enjoy the privilege of having students from other cultures to stay with them. The school ensures that homes are of a good standard, and that the families are made aware of the challenges which foreign students face in adapting to New Zealand life. Unless specially requested, students will have a single room and will not be placed in the same homestay as a student of the same nationality or language group. Homestay includes breakfast and dinner Monday to Friday. Lunch is also provided at weekends.

### **TRANSFER**

Students are met at Auckland International Airport and taken by taxi/shuttle to their host families in Whitianga. We also offer a return transfer service for short term students.

### **COUNSELLING**

Before beginning their course, students receive detailed counselling in their own language. They are told about the school and its philosophy of learning, and about the town. They also have the opportunity to ask any questions. First language counselling after the first day is freely available by arrangement.

We encourage students to use English at all times. Our staff make themselves available to assist students in any way they can to help make their stay with us more enjoyable.

### **GROUP TOURS**

Coromandel Outdoor Language Centre also caters for short term (1 - 4 weeks) study tours for groups, by arrangement. These tours can be designed to suit specific needs and may include a short sightseeing tour at the end of the visit.

All students receive a "Certificate of Achievement" on successful completion of their course.

With our high teaching standards, our beautiful location, and our unique programme of lessons, activities and homestay, Coromandel Outdoor Language Centre offers students a truly enjoyable and effective way to learn English.

## REGISTRATION PROCEDURE

The following procedure is our usual method of receiving information and processing the enrolment of students. We would appreciate it if you could follow these steps:

1. Send us the registration with the following details :
  - student's name
  - number of weeks required
  - which course is required
  - if our transfer service is required
  - student's age
  - starting and finishing dates
  - homestay dates and personal preferences
  - any special requests.
  
2. We will confirm the booking promptly. The advice of the fee payable for the booking will usually be sent either at the time of confirmation or as soon as possible within the next few days.
  
3. We will send the Letter of Acceptance, transfer stickers, and our transfer information sheet for the student by mail with any other special information required. Please do not issue the Letter of Acceptance until you have been paid in full by the student.
  
4. Homestay family details will be sent approximately 4 weeks before the student is due to commence his or her course. Please advise if the student is a smoker or non smoker, special food preferences, requests a homestay with or without children and/or pets and any hobbies or interests they may have. We try to match students with the most suitable host family, at times due to demand we may not be able to satisfy all their requests but will do our best to make their New Zealand homestay as enjoyable and memorable as possible.

## CONDITIONS OF ENROLMENT

**REGISTRATION** is necessary at least 2 weeks before the course commences.

**FULL PAYMENT OF ALL FEES IS DUE** before the course commences.

**NO TRANSFER OF FEES.**

**COURSE CHANGES** only at the discretion of the Director or, in his absence, the School Manager.

**DISCIPLINARY PROCEDURES:** Students will normally be given two verbal warnings and one written warning in an attempt to remedy the problem prior to expulsion. In any case where a student is in breach of New Zealand law then expulsion can be immediate. Immigration authorities will then be informed that the student is no longer enrolled at Coromandel Outdoor Language Centre. If students are absent for 2 weeks without prior approval, expulsion can be automatic.

### STUDENT COMPLAINTS

1. Students should first complain to their teacher.
2. If necessary students can later approach the Director of Studies.
3. If necessary students can later approach the School Director or, in his absence, the School Manager.
4. If necessary students can later approach English New Zealand – PO Box 2577, Auckland.

6. If necessary students can later approach the International Education Appeal Authority, Tribunals Unit, Private bag 32001, Panama Street, Wellington 6146

**REFUNDS:** All fees are converted to NZ\$ on the day of receipt and the refund is the equivalent of the NZ\$ value on the day of receipt. All applications for refunds must be accompanied by the original documents issued by Coromandel Outdoor Language Centre along with evidence that the documents were not used to obtain a visa to come to New Zealand. All refunded monies must go to the person from whom Coromandel Outdoor Language Centre received the monies.

- (1) If students wish to withdraw within 8 days of starting a course, students will receive as a refund all the monies received which exceed NZ\$500 or 10% of the amount paid, whichever is lesser.
- (2) If students wish to withdraw after 8 days of starting a course, this is possible only in special circumstances approved by the Director or, in his absence, the School Manager. The application for this refund must be made at least 2 weeks before the course is to end. Students will receive as a refund all the relevant fees less 25% handling fee.

**PUBLIC HOLIDAYS:** No compensation is given for days the school is closed due to Public Holidays. The normal weekly rate is payable for weeks in which there are holidays. The Public Holidays dates are available upon your request.

**AGES ACCEPTED:** Minimum age 16 years for individual students.

**HOMESTAY ACCOMMODATION** is arranged only for the duration of the studies, except in special circumstances. The family must be respected, their home is not a hotel.

**LIABILITY:** Coromandel Outdoor Language Centre cannot be held responsible for any sickness, injury, damage or loss incurred within the Language Centre or on Language Centre activities. It is the responsibility of the student to arrange personal insurance. Coromandel Outdoor Language Centre can provide information about insurance. Coromandel Outdoor Language Centre cannot be held responsible for any Language Centre closure due to circumstances outside the control of Coromandel Outdoor Language Centre. There is no refund in such circumstances. If the weather is unsuitable for any activity an alternative activity will be arranged. No refunds for cancelled/alternative activities.

**ALL STUDENTS UNDER THE AGE OF 18** who have no legal guardian resident in New Zealand, must stay at Coromandel Outdoor Language Centre arranged accommodation.

**AT PRESENT GOVERNMENT TAXES** include 15% Goods and Services Tax (GST). If Government taxes increase, such increases will be added to fees.

**PERSONAL LIABILITY:** The Law concerning personal liability in New Zealand is entirely contained in the Injury Prevention Rehabilitation and Compensation Act 2001 (Section 20). No personal injury claim can be made against Coromandel Outdoor Language Centre or any other company, organisation or any individual.

**PASSPORT:** Students must bring their passports to Coromandel Outdoor Language Centre on the first day of lessons.

### STUDENT FEES PROTECTION POLICY:

- (1) The fees of all students on a student visa are placed in a Trust Fund operated by the Auckland Regional Chamber of Commerce on behalf of English New Zealand.
- (2) All student fees are protected with a Bank Bond held by the Trustees, Gilligan Shepherd, 253 Queen Street, Auckland (telephone (09) 309 5191). In the event that an application needs to be made with the Trustees, please apply in writing.

# INFORMATION FOR STUDENTS VISITING NEW ZEALAND AND COROMANDEL OUTDOOR LANGUAGE CENTRE



## CLIMATE

Whitianga has a moderate climate with changeable weather; the winter (June, July, August) is cool (average daily maximum 14°C) and often wet; the summer (December, January, February) is warm (average maximum 24°C) and drier. People usually swim in the sea between December and April. There is no snow in winter.

## CLOTHES

People mainly wear casual clothes. From Autumn to Spring warm sweaters are necessary, umbrellas and a waterproof jacket. Comfortable sports shoes for walking for many of our activities are essential.

## FOOD

New Zealanders eat a lot of meat, fish, and fresh vegetables, usually cooked in a simple style. Food is not spicy. There is a good selection of cafes and restaurants in Whitianga, where a variety of different food can be found. All meat purchased in New Zealand supermarkets is halal.

## THE TOWN

It is a small town with about 4,000 people, but the population grows to 40,000 for a few weeks in the summer holiday season. Whitianga is a summer resort town for New Zealanders, because of the beautiful beaches, fishing, and native forests. The main industries around the town are fishing, farming, forestry and tourism. There is no public transport system in Whitianga. Students either walk, bike or taxi.

## FAMILY LIFE

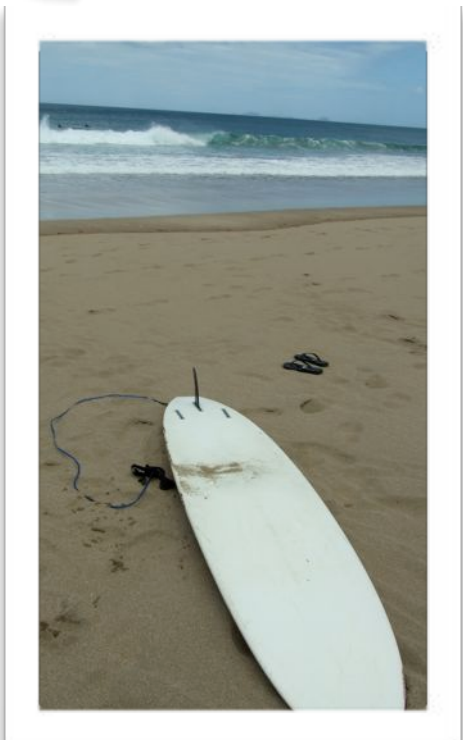
